



EUGENE KANSKIS CUP

NOTICE OF RACE

1. Main Prize

1.1. The main prize of the race is Silver Cup, established by the Yachting Union of Lithuania to the fastest boat and won by the famous Latvian sailor Eugene Kanskis (1907-1986) with yacht 'Amata' at Nida Regatta in 1938.

1.2. Since 1988 till 2002 Eugene Kanskis family awarded this Cup as a regular prize for the achievements in the development of sailing sports in Latvia and it was presented to the 15 best sailors of the country.

2. Rules

2.1. Since 2010 the Eugene Kanskis Silver Cup will be challenged in the longest race of the Riga Gulf Regatta.

2.2. All eligible boats of this trace may participate in this challenge.

2.3. The Eugene Kanskis Silver Cup will be awarded to the overall winner of ORC measured boats by corrected time, calculated on basis of ORC rating coefficient.

2.4. The Eugene Kanskis Silver Cup becomes a property of boat which has won it three years in a row.

2.5. Name of the winning boat and the corresponding year will be engraved on the Cup, as well as the pennant (if any) of the yacht will be attached to it.

2.6. Meantime the Eugene Kanskis Silver Cup is kept at the place of honor in the office of the Offshore Racing Association of Latvia.
