Regulations

of the international yacht race (regatta)

"Baltic Sea – the Sea of Friendship" 2011

International yacht race (hereinafter referred to as regatta) "Baltic Sea – the Sea of Friendship" has been held annually since 2005 in accordance with the calendar of sports events, approved by the Agency for Sport of the Kaliningrad region. Since 2009, the regatta has been on the list of sports events under the aegis of the Russian Federation of Yachting.

1. Goals and objectives of the regatta

The main aim of the regatta is to develop, promote and popularize yachting in Russia, particularly among young people and residents of the Kaliningrad region.

The objectives of the regatta are to increase sportsmanship and improve skills of yachtsmen, identify the best crews, develop and strengthen friendly relations among countries.

2. The organizers of the regatta are

- the Government of the Kaliningrad region;
- Kaliningrad Regional Federation of Yachting (KOFPS);
- Administration of the Pionerskiy city administration.

3. Venue and date

The regatta is held on July 8-10, 2011 in the Pionerskiy port, the Baltic Sea, the Kaliningrad region, Russia

3.1 Programme of the regatta:

July 8 "Jantarniy bereg" - "Pionerskiy "

Arrival of the participants;

10.00-12.00

A meeting of the regatta committee, registration of the participants, a control measurement for dinghies;

14.00 –

Regatta event: dinghy race № 1;

14.00-20.00 –

A meeting of the regatta committee, registration of the participants, a control measure for cruising yachts;

19.30-19.45 –

A meeting of yacht captains and/or their representatives;

20.00 –

The opening of the regatta at the exhibition area of the port.

July 9

08.00 -

Regatta event: cruising yachts race N^o 1

11.00 -

Theatrical performance: Neptune welcomes the regatta participants

Regatta event: dinghy race

Regatta event: cruising yachts race N^o2 and N^o3.

Racing shall not begin after 15.00

19.00 - Awarding the winners and participants of the regatta at the exhibition area of the port complex.

20.00 - Buffet dinner in the port.

July 10

Departure of the teams to their base sites.

3.2 Races are held for two courses:

"Alpha" course - cruising yacht race: in the Pionerskiy port water area (from cape "Gvardeiskiy" to Svetlogorsk lift tower);

"Success" course - dinghy race for the "Laser", "Ray", "Optimist" and "Cadet" classes in the Pioneer part water area.

3.3 The race guidelines and the measurer instructions will be made public and be available from 10:00 on July 8 during the registration and the work of the regatta committee. The control measurements will be given in the measurer instructions.

3.4 Courses are announced on the day of the competition. Course schemes are to be given to the participants not later than one hour prior to the start of a race.

4. Rules and regulations in effect during the regatta

- International regulations for yacht races ISAF 2009-2012;

- Yacht race regulations adopted by the Russian Federation of Yachting 2009 (PPS 2009-2012);
- Current boat class regulations;
- Instructions for the Tonnage Measurement KWR for cruising yachts;
- Sailing regulations;
- The present Regulations of the regatta.

The time limit of completing the course for cruiser yachts is 120% of the corrected time of the first yacht of the test group.

5. Participation

1). Cruising yachts of three groups (up to 8 meters long, up to 10 meters long and more than 10 meters) take part in three handicap races. There are no age restrictions for race participants;

2). Participation in the "Laser" and "Ray" class dinghy race:

- Participation is limited to those of no more than 21 years of age by Dec. 31, 2011;

3). Participation of the dinghy race:

- the "Optimist" class dinghy race – male participants, no older than 15 years of age as of December 31, 2011;
- the "Cadet" class dinghy race – male participants, no older than 17 years of age as of December 31, 2011 this year.

Races for female crews and the "Laser" class boats are held separately provided at least 4 boats register for the race. If less than 4 boats register for this race, only the winner taking the first place is awarded.

6. Entry and registration

6.1 Registration forms are to be submitted to the Organizing Authority of the regatta before June 25, 2011 (see Appendix № 1):

6.2 Registration, measuring, and submitting documents to the Regatta Committee for all classes of yachts are held from 15 to 21 o'clock on July 8.

A. Papers to be submitted to the Regatta Committee by the participants of cruising yacht races are the following ones:

- a registration and entry form, signed by the yacht owner, or his representative. The form shall contain the following words: "I will obey the regulations and all other rules in effect during the regatta";
- a valid measurement certificate of the yacht;
- captains (helmsmen) are to present the yacht certificate;
- power of attorney from the yacht owner to navigate the yacht;
- a technical inspection certificate for the boat to comply with Category 4 cruises (2011 KOFPS);
- a liability insurance policy to third parties;
- an insurance policy against accidents (no less than 100 000 rubles);

B. Papers required for entry in the junior and youth races:

- the current measurement certificate (rating certificate);
- helmsmen are to present their sailing certificate;
- birth certificate, or a passport;
- an inspection certificate for the vessel seaworthiness of 2011;
- a signed entry form;
- an insurance policy for no less than 100 000 rubles;
- a collective request from the organization to participate in the race (the sample is given in Annex 1-2009).

7. Entry fee

7.1 The entry fee is 100 rubles per person.

Participants who sent their registration forms after June 25, 2011, shall pay a higher fee of 300 rubles per person. Junior participants shall not pay any participation fee.

8. Winners and their awarding

8.1 The winners in the cruising yachts race are determined by the handicap for the minimum corrected time of the three races.

8.2 The winners in the "Laser", "Ray", "Optimist" and "Cadet" class boats are determined by the linear principle given in Annex "A" RRS 2009. Provided 5 races are held, the results of all of them are scored. Provided a yacht takes part in 6 or 7 races - the result of the worst race is not taken into account. Races are pronounced to have taken place providing at least three races have been held.

8.3 Winners in all yacht class races are awarded the regatta prizes and medals, and are given pennants and other souvenirs by the administration of the Kaliningrad region, the Pionerskiy city, the "Amber Coast" - Pionerskiy " and sponsors.

8.4 The purchasing of the regatta prizes, as well as accommodation and meals for junior participants are covered by the Pionerskiy city administration.

9. Information

9.1 All information for the regatta participants will be placed

- on the bulletin board in the Port of Pionerskiy from 10 o'clock on July 8, 2011.

9.2 on the website KOFPS - www.kofps.ru, info@kofps.ru

9.3 Accommodation and meals for junior participants are totally under the responsibility the Organizing Authority.

9.4 Delegations bringing more than five dinghies shall provide a judge and a support boat.

9.5 Responsibility for insurance, boat and crews safety during the race are borne by captains, ship owners, or their representatives. The Organizing Authority and judges shall not bear responsibility for the

lives or belongings of the participants, as well as for any injury, damage to their property during the races, or in connection with them.

9.6 The owners and captains of the boats are obliged to insure the liability to third parties and provide individual insurance policies for the period of the tournament.

9.7 Competitors shall comply with the rules of environmental safety and order in the regatta sites.
